broccoli	bush bean, beet, carrot, celery, chard, cucumber, dill, lettuce, mint, nasturtium, onion, oregano, potato, rosemary, sage, spinach, tomato	pole and snap beans, strawberries	avoid following with cabbage family	best full sun, tolerates light shade
carrots	bean, brussel sprout, cabbage, chive, leaf lettuce, leek, onion, pea, pepper, red radish, rosemary, sage, tomato	celery, dill, parsnip	avoid rotating with celery, dill, fennel, parsley, parsnip	best full sun, tolerates light shade
cauliflower	bush bean, beet, carrot, celery, cucumber, dill, lettuce, mint, nasturtium, onion, pea, potato, rosemary, sage, spinach	pole bean, strawberry	precede with nitrogen fixing cover crop, avoid following cabbage family	best full sun, tolerates light shade
corn	bush bean, beet, cabbage, cataloupe, cucumber, parsley, pea, early potato, pumpkin, squash	tomato	precede with a nitrogen-fixing crop	full sun
cucumber	bush bean, broccoli, cabbage, corn, dill, eggplant, lettuce, nasturtium, pea, radish, sunflower, tomato	aromatic herbs, potato	avoid rotating with other cucumber family	full sun
eggplant	bush bean, pea, pepper, potato	fennel	follow beans or peas	full sun
garlic	beet, lettuce	bean, pea	should not follow any onion family	best full sun, tolerates light shade
lettuce	everything but especially carrot, garlic, onion radish	none	avoid following radichio, endive, escarole, artichoke	best full sun, tolerates light shade
onions	beet, cabbage, carrot, early lettuce, parsnip, pepper, spinach, strawberry, tomato, turnip	asparagus, bean, pea, sage	follow squash, lettuce. do not follow any onion family or legume	best full sun, tolerates light shade
peas	carrot, celery, corn, cucumber, eggplant, parsley, early potato, radish, spinach, strawberry, sweet pepper, turnip	onion, late potato	follow with kale	best full sun, tolerates light shade
peppers	carrot, onion, parsnip, pea	fennel, kohlrabi	do not follow with tomatoes, eggplant, potatoes	full sun
spinach	cabbage, celery, legumes, lettuce, onion, pea, radish, strawberry	potatoes	benefits all succeeding crops, do not follow legumes	full sun to partial shade
summer squash	celery, corn, nasturtium, onion, radish	potato	avoid following winter squash, pumpkins, cucumbers, melons	full sun
winter squash pumpkin	celery, corn, onion, radish	potatoe	avoid following summer squash, cucumbers, melons	full sun
tomatoes	basil, bush bean, cabbage, carrot, celery, chive, cucumber, garlic, head lettuc, marigold, mint, nasturtium, onion, parsley, pepper, pot marigold	pole bean, dill, fennel, potato	avoid following potatoes, peppers, eggplant	full sun
turnip	onion, pea	potato	avoid following cabbage	avoid following winter squash, pumpkins, cucumbers, melons
